The sessions are interactive with a practical element; and all attendees will receive an information pack and certificate of attendance.

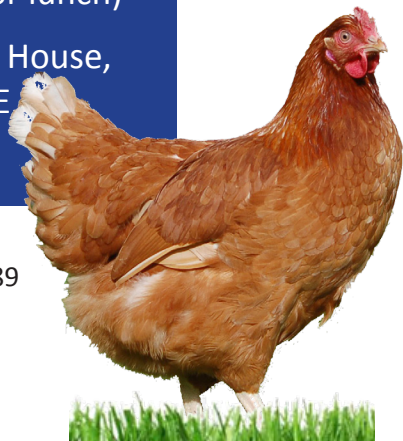
